FALS Guidelines

A candidate can apply in any ONE of the following categories: Exam Fellowship / Non Exam Fellowship

Eligibility criteria:

- IAGES MEMBERSHIP IS A MUST.
- Those who are not members may apply for membership online. See the website www.iages.in for more details.
- Post graduate degree in surgery is mandatory.
- The number of years of experience in laparoscopic surgery should be a minimum of 2 years (including experience in laparoscopy as a postgraduate surgical resident).
- A resident or junior consultant should obtain a certificate of experience from the HOD of the hospital/Institution as a supportive document. Attach soft copies of the MBBS, MS, or DNB certificate and MCI/ State registration certificate during membership registration.
- Members of collaborating associations who have signed an MOU with IAGES are also eligible.
 They are expected to get their application endorsed by the respective collaborating association prior to joining the course.
- Candidates also have to register for the IAGES ELSA 2026 Congress, to be held in Mumbai from February 13 to 15, 2026 in order to attend Live Surgeries, Lectures and Convocation Ceremony.

(A)FIAGES: NON-EXAMINATION CATEGORY:

- Suitable for those candidates working as faculty in teaching institutions and all surgeons with more than 10-year experience in doing a laparoscopy.
- Already an IAGES member or applied for IAGES membership
- Number of laparoscopies done in the last 10 years: >250
- Would be eligible to receive the FIAGES fellowship on satisfactory completion of the FIAGES course and the informal interview.

(B) FIAGES: EXAMINATION CATEGORY

- Suitable for those with a minimum of 2 years experience in laparoscopic surgery (Includes experience in laparoscopy as a postgraduate surgical resident).
- Fellow should have experience certificate from HOD, Employer or self if running own hospital.
- Fellow should present an online Log Book. Total 25 cases including all Assisted/ Operated laparoscopic surgeries.

Logbook (For Exam & Non Exam Fellowship delegates only)

- Age/Sex/Surgery/Role/Post-op course/Complication/Remarks
- Role Assisted/under supervision/Independent (as drop down)
- Post-op course Uneventful / Eventful (as drop down)
- Complications Infection, Bleeding, Leak, Stricture, Obstruction, Others
- Remarks Type the outcome of the event, if patient has been conservatively managed, Recovered, Diseased, Transferred, etc



FALS Colorectal Guidelines

Assessment of FALS Colorectal fellowship candidates will be conducted by IAGES Central Office.

Suggested Reading:

Any textbooks/ journals pertaining to Basic & Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery.

Schedule:

Self-paced Online lectures: Link shall be provided to registered candidates on or before January 1, 2026. The candidate needs to complete all lectures + short evaluation on or before February 11, 2026 in order to be eligible to attend the onsite module.

Onsite Module: Will include Hands on Training sessions, Lectures/ Panel discussions & exams/ viva on February 12, 2026.

MCQ Exam:

Date: February 12, 2026

Time: 60 minutes (Maximum number of marks: 100)

The exam will have 100 MCQ questions (single best response type) and will be conducted via an online link. The candidate has to be present at the venue in person.

Practical Examination:

Interview/assessment for approximately 10 minutes on each candidate. The candidates will be divided in to batches and interviewed by senior faculty members of IAGES depending upon the number of candidates. Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the interview.

Endotrainer Evaluation:

The candidates will be divided in to batches and examined by faculty members of IAGES. Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the Endotrainer evaluation.

Outcome of written and practical assessment will be prepared by the organizing team and to be signed and to be sent to the President with a copy to Hon Secretary Office and FIAGES board and results will be published in the IAGES website.

Successful candidates would be expected to attend IAGES ELSA 2026 and convocation ceremony on February 15, 2026 in order to receive the fellowship certificate. The Fellowship certificate would be posted to the candidate if he /she fails to attend two consecutive annual congress/convocation.
