



FALS ONCOLOGY GUIDELINES

TYPES OF FELLOWSHIP AND THEIR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA A) NON EXAMINATION CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- IAGES membership is a prerequisite for the FALS course. Non-members can apply simultaneously online on www.iages.in.
- Minimum of 10 years experience after post graduation and Minimum 7 years experience in Laparoscopic general surgery Independently / Mch / Dr N B general surgery.
- Should have performed at least 30 laparoscopic procedures independently.
- Should attend fellowship course on all 3 days and appear for Interview.
- Submission of logbook of Laparoscopic surgery cases certified by HOD or self if working in his own setup at the time of interview.
- Submission of a CD, recorded in two different surgical procedures is desirable but not mandatory since the recording facility is not available in every OT setup.
- If the above criteria are not fulfilled he or she will not be shifted to the examination category.
- All candidates will be interviewed by the IAGES board before conferring the award.

B) EXAMINATION CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- IAGES membership is a prerequisite for the FALS course. Non-members can apply simultaneously online on www.iages.in.
- Minimum of 5 years experience after PG and minimum 3 years experience in Laparoscopic surgery independently.
- Should have performed a minimum of 15 Laparoscopic procedures independently or under supervision.
- Should attend Fellowship course on all 3 days appear for Interview.
- Have to appear for written examination and interview. Read all relevant topics before attending the fellowship course.
- Submission of logbook of Laparoscopic cases certified by HOD or self if working in his own setup at the time of interview.

Assessment of FIAGES fellowship candidates will be conducted by IAGES Central Office.

Any textbooks/journals pertaining to Basic & Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery.

SCHEDULE

Self-paced Online lectures: Link shall be provided to registered candidates on or before January 1, 2026. The

candidate needs to complete all lectures + short evaluation on or before February

11, 2026 in order to be eligible to attend the onsite module.

Onsite Module : Will include Hands on Training sessions, Lectures/ Panel discussions & exams/

viva on February 12, 2026.

MCQ EXAM

Date: February 12, 2026

Time: 60 minutes (Maximum number of marks: 100)

The exam will have 100 MCQ questions (single best response type) and will be conducted via an online link. The candidate has to be present at the venue in person.

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

Interview/assessment for approximately 10 minutes on each candidate. The candidates will be divided in to batches and interviewed by senior faculty members of IAGES depending upon the number of candidates. Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the interview.

ENDOTRAINER EVALUATION

The candidates will be divided in to batches and examined by faculty members of IAGES. Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the Endotrainer evaluation.

Outcome of written and practical assessment will be prepared by the organizing team and to be signed and to be sent to the President with a copy to Hon Secretary Office and FIAGES board and results will be published in the IAGES website.

Successful candidates would be expected to attend IAGES ELSA 2026 and convocation ceremony on February 15, 2026 in order to receive the fellowship certificate. The Fellowship certificate would be posted to the candidate if he /she fails to attend two consecutive annual congress/convocation
